The Alaska Songbird Institute was founded in January 2013 at Creamer's Field Migratory Waterfowl Refuge, a 2,000+ acre state wildlife refuge in the heart of Fairbanks.

Our initial work has been to adopt two long-term avian research/education projects on the refuge: the Creamer's Field Migration Station and the Swallow Ecology Project.

Through these projects we integrate research and science education by partnering with students, teachers, and community volunteers of all ages to collect long-term data on the migration and productivity of Alaska's birds.

Our work aims to build scientific literacy and inspire Alaska's next generation of scientists.
