Noble Paws is a 501.c.3 nonprofit that teaches people experiencing disabilities how to run their own dog team. Our adaptive equipment can accommodate most any ability, including cerebral palsy, autism, paralysis and down syndrome.

## Our Goals

Each season (January – March) we run a **Mushing School** and host a large sled dog event. Our goals are to:

1. Teach at least 20 people experiencing a disability how to independently run a dog team.
2. Hold the first ever dog mushing race solely for people experiencing disabilities.
3. Host the Second Annual **Golden Heart Sled Dog Expo**, offering free dog mushing rides to anyone with a disability.
