Calypso Farm & Ecology Center's mission is to encourage local food production and environmental awareness through hands-on education in natural and farming ecosystems. Calypso seeks to connect Fairbanks to their food sources through CSA and community markets, and enable community members to grow their own food through educational programs for all ages: ecological gardening workshops, onfarm field trips and camps, and intensive Farmer Training Program, and the School Garden Initiative.

We believe that our educational programs and food justice initiatives align with Co-op Market's goals to promote awareness and access to healthy food, rooted in the local economy. If selected for the Lend-A-Hand Program, Calypso's proceeds would support Hunter Elementary's Schoolyard garden, not far from the Co-op Market. The School Garden Initiative offers exciting summer programs that provide low-income Fairbanks youth an opportunity to physically work, play and learn about growing their own food. In spring and fall, the gardens serve as engaging outdoor classrooms for students to learn about plant life, nutrition, and gardening through hands-on activities. In the summer of 2017, Hunter will host a LEAF (Learning Ecology and Alaskan Farming) Camp session and EATinG (Engaging Alaskan Teens in Gardening) Program for ages 11 and up, offering students further opportunity to learn how to grow and prepare their own food. Funding through the Lend-A-Hand program will be put toward the general operating budget of the Hunter School Garden, helping to cover the cost of seeds, tools and other gardening supplies, support staff maintaining the gardens and leading educational programs, and keep program costs affordable for all families.

Thank you so much for considering our request. We would be honored to be chosen as recipients of the Lend-A-Hand Program, partnering with Co-op Market to strengthen the community's local food system and education resources for healthy decision making.
