Dear Co-Op Market, Grocery and Deli,

I am writing on behalf of the Fairbanks Animal Shelter Fund to ask that we be selected as one of the charities for the 2017 Lend-a-Hand Program.


The Fairbanks Animal Shelter Fund is an all-volunteer 501(c)(3) charity founded in 2002 to augment and supplement care and services at the Fairbanks North Star Borough Animal Shelter. Since our founding, we have been able to purchase supplies and equipment and also to provide veterinary care for stray and neglected animals to move them on to adoptive homes. With strong community support and frugal management of the money entrusted to us, we've been able to save hundreds of animals that otherwise would have been euthanized. By far, our biggest expenditure is veterinary care.
