The Shelter Fund is an all-volunteer 501(c)(3) Alaska nonprofit corporation that is the support group for the Fairbanks North Star Borough Animal Shelter. Founded in 2002, we raise funds to provide supplementary veterinary care, supplies and equipment not provided in the Borough budget. The bulk of our expenditures are for specialized veterinary care so the animals can move on to adoptive homes. It is our belief that the humane care of healthy domestic animals advances the well-being of the human members of our community. It also promotes public health for the human citizenry. Thus, our goals are aligned with the goals of the Co-Op Market.

Dear Applicant


