As a new school (in our second year), we are seeking sources for financial support to supplement our curriculum. Our pedagogy is "Waldorf" inspired and includes such things as self sufficiency, food production and preparation, local community involvement, art, music and family involvement. Several of our staff are gardeners and we are presently making plans for a school garden.
