Interior AIDS Association (IAA) is a local nonprofit organization that shares the Co-op's work to create a "knowledgeable community informed about choices that impact personal wellness." Our core purpose is to improve Interior Alaskans' quality of life through harm reduction.

Available Services:

- HIV education for individuals and groups at risk
- Education/support for HIV+ individuals to decrease their risk of infecting others
- Medication assisted treatment to eliminate client dependence on pain pills and heroin
- Syringe exchange for safer injections
- Free HIV and Hepatitis C Testing and free condoms

What is HIV?

Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) is a virus spread through certain body fluids that attacks the body's immune system, specifically the CD4 cells.

What is AIDS?

Over time, HIV can destroy so many CD4 cells that the body can't fight off infections and disease. These opportunistic infections or cancers take advantage of a very weak immune system and signal that the person has Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome.

HIV is not transmitted by:

- Air or Water
- Saliva, Sweat, Tears, or Closed-Mouth kissing
- Insects or Pets
- Sharing Toilets, Food, or Drinks

HIV risks:

- Most commonly through the exchange of body fluids. during unprotected sex or sharing injection equipment (IV drug needles, etc.)
- Less commonly from mother to child during pregnancy, birth, or breastfeeding and also by being stuck by an HIV-contaminated needle.

Case Management

Client Services staff can help with problem-solving, goal setting, and coping skills for persons living with HIV/AIDS and their families and friends.

IMAT offers individualized and effective outpatient treatment for pain pill/heroin addiction.

Our affordable, confidential program includes counseling and education with medication that can decrease your cravings and feelings of withdrawal.

IMAT provides outpatient counseling and medication-assisted treatment on a sliding fee scale. Medicaid and insurance are also accepted.

Who is eligible?

- Adults 18+ who are currently addicted to heroin or other opioids.
- Pregnant women and injection drug users are given priority in admissions.



HIV Prevention

Free Testing

Free, confidential HIV and Hepatitis C testing is available by walk-in or appointment Mon - Thurs, 11 am - 3 pm.

We use OraQuick Rapid test which is an oral swab or a finger stick. Both tests produce results in 20 minutes.

Syringe Access

Northern Exchange provides access to sterile syringes and other safer injection supplies for injection drug users.

Free Resources

- Large and small containers for safe syringe disposal
- Condoms and lube
- Narcan opioid/heroin overdose reversal kits


This letter is in response to your request for a copy of the determination letter for the above named organization.
